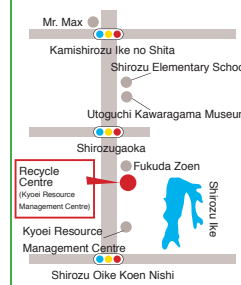
Midori no Recycle

Recyclable Items
Fresh branch cuttings that are no more than 90 cm long and 15cm wide from household trees and leaves.
* Grass, bamboo, roots, dead wood and dead leaves cannot be recycled. Please dispose of them as

Self-Delivery Open Weekdays 9am – 4pm
Please bring your cuttings and leaves to the Kyoei Resource Management Centre's Recycling Centre (at Shirozugaoka 1-23). No special bags or binding are required. A processing fee of ¥110 per 10kg will be charged.

Pickups
① Some areas employ a collection company to pick up your branch cuttings. Please call the collection company to arrange a pickup time.
② Places such as community centres sell bags specifically for branch cuttings and leaves (¥330 for 3 (Tax incl.) and binding (¥330 for 3 (Tax incl.)). Fill out the accompanying form and leave the bags at the time and place designated by the community centre.

Hazardous Waste

Batteries (Manganese and alkali), **Fluorescent Lamp Tubes**, **Mercury Thermometers** and **Wire Coat Hangers** These are collected in boxes marked "有害ゴミボックス" (Hazardous Waste), which are in community centres, Kasuga City Hall and Iki Iki Plaza.
* **Incandescent light bulbs, fairy lights and flash bulbs** should be disposed of as **ceramic and metallic objects**.
* Please take **watch batteries** (button cells), **rechargeable batteries** (nickel cadmium "nicad" batteries and nickel-hydrogen batteries), **mobile phone batteries**, etc. to the place they were purchased for disposal.

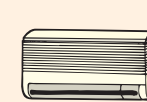

● Recycling Household Electrical Appliances (Air conditioners, TVs (not plasmas/LCDs), fridges, freezers, washing machines)

Please dispose of the above 5 types of electrical appliances via any of the methods below.. Types of appliances that can be recycled and recycling prices are subject to change.

- ① Have the shop you purchased the appliance from or the shop you are purchasing a replacement from take your old appliance in for recycling.
- ② Call Best Denki Customer Support Fukuoka (651-9161) or Fukuoka West District Centre (632-6155) and have them take your old appliances.
- ③ Have your local garbage collection company take in your old appliances.

● Recycling Computers (Desktop PCs, laptops, CRT and LCD monitors)

Home computers will be collected and recycled by their original manufacturers. Please dispose of your computers via the following method.

- ① Ask the manufacturer of your computer to collect it for recycling.
- ② The manufacturer will send you a bank transfer form, so use that form to pay the manufacturer's recycling fee at any bank.
※ Do not pay the manufacturer if your computer has a "PC リサイクル" (PC Recycle) logo. Such computers have already had their recycling fee paid as part of the price on initial purchase.
- ③ The manufacturer will send you an "Eco Yu-Pack" postal form.
- ④ Pack up your computer and post it at a post office, or call the post office for a clerk to come collect it (No extra fees apply for collection).
