Processing method of large-sized garbage

[How to Reserve]

- (1) By the 20th of every month (or the previous business day if closed), make a phone reservation with the collector. (Mon.-Fri. from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm)
- (2) When making a reservation, check the number of stickers required for taking out the waste and purchase them at the garbage bag dealer.
- (3) Enter the reservation number and date of disposal on the sticker, and put it out at the designated place by 10:00 pm on the day of disposal.

Number of stickers to put on large-sized garbage (guideline)

1 sticker (One person could carry)
A gas range, a bicycle, a futon set and a stove etc.

2 stickers (Two people could carry)
Chest, bed, study desk spring mattress, etc.



Note: Up to 3 items of large-sized garbage can be taken out at a time.
Note: Please check with the collector at the time of booking for the amount of stickers.
Note: For one time garbage, such as when moving, ask the collector to collect it one time (charged). Please use designated bags and large-sized garbage stickers for temporary collection, too.

How to Properly Put Out Kasuga City Household Garbage

- ◎ Please be sure to put it in Kasuga City designated bags (sold at such as the supermarkets) and take out **from sunset to 10 pm**.
- ◎ Garbage bags that do not follow the rules will be left uncollected with a “violation seal” attached.
- ◎ It is not possible to dispose of office waste as household garbage.
- ◎ You can put out up to **two garbage bags at a time**.

◎Independent house → Please put along the road in front of the house.
















◎If you are in an apartment house→ (1) Please put it at the dedicated garbage area.

(2) If there is only one place for burnable waste or one place for non-burnable garbage

place at the dedicated storage, put them both at the same place.

(3) If there is no dedicated place, please put along the road in front of the apartment.

Note: There are some cases where garbage cannot be collected on the road in front of the house, such as a narrow road. If you do not know the place to put garbage, please check with the neighbors, community hall, apartment manager, and etc.

Home electrical appliances

(Air conditioner, TV, freezer, refrigerator, washing machine, clothes dryer)

Please use one of the following methods.

“Recycling fee” and “collection transportation fee” are charged.

- Have a home appliance retailer collect it. (Please contact the individual store for details)
- Have the local collector handle the collection.

PC recycling

Please apply to Renet Japan Co., Ltd. for collection on the Internet. (Not available on the phone) It can be collected free of charge from home by courier the shortest next day, and there is also a data erasure service such as personal information.

Items prohibited to dispose of

Items listed in the box below are prohibited items. As we cannot process in the city, please ask the dealer, maker or specialized processing supplier.

Engine oil, construction waste, automobile parts, incineration ash, thinner, fireproof safes, tires, electric water heaters, agricultural chemicals, batteries, pianos, propane gas cylinders, paints, bowling balls, chemicals, etc.

In addition, please refer to the Environment Division about the processing method of motorcycles and motorbikes.
